

2011 JUNIOR GOLF COLUMBIA HILLS COUNTRY CLUB

Dear Parents and Grandparents:

Welcome to *Columbia Hills Junior Golf, 2011*. We are looking forward to a great year. Junior Golf is a program designed to introduce golf to children and to help them develop their game. All children between the ages of 6 and 18 are eligible to join. Junior Golf Day is Friday and is a six session program with the following schedule:

June 24	July 8	July 15
July 22	July 29	August 5

Junior golfers may play either, 1, 3, 5, or 9 holes. Determination of how many holes to play is a factor of ability and preference. If you have any questions about how many holes your child should play, please let us know. The hole groupings are:

- 1 Hole**
- 3 Holes**
- 5 Holes**
- YWGA (Young Women's Golf Association) - 5 holes**
- 9 Holes (front of the fairway)**
- Championship 9 Holes (White tees)**

All Junior Golfers should be here by 7:45 each morning. There will be a short Junior Golf Etiquette Session followed by golf. After golf, cookies will be available at the driving range. Following the snack will be a clinic with the Golf Professionals.

We ask that parents volunteer to walk with a junior group at least three times. It is important that we have at least one parent in each group of 1, 3, 5 and short 9 Holes. Parents who are walking with groups are for supervision, maintaining pace of play and assuring etiquette rules are being followed. Please do not give instruction to the golfers while they are playing.

There is a mandatory meeting for at least one parent or grandparent at the first week of Junior Golf. This meeting will be conducted from 8:00 - 8:15 a.m. while the junior golfers are in their etiquette session.

Junior Golfers are required to follow the **Columbia Hills C.C.** dress code. The **golf dress code** is golf shorts or golf pants and a golf shirt with a collar. No jeans, No cut-offs, No sweat suits, No T-Shirts, No tank tops. Socks must be worn with golf shoes or tennis shoes. Sun Screen and hats are recommended.

All Junior Golfers and accompanying parents must walk. Exceptions will be made for medical reasons and/or other Physical challenges.

Each Junior Golfer must have their own clubs and golf balls. If you are in need of clubs, please call the pro shop. We have several equipment options available.
